



1 WHEREAS, Section 10:193-1 states that the District Attorney may establish reduced  
2 fee rates for individuals who lack the financial capability to pay the full fee, but in no event  
3 shall the reduced fee be less than \$100 for any individual participant;

4 WHEREAS, the program has been operating at a deficit for five years, with the  
5 program participants, including the District Attorney's Office, the Police Department and  
6 SAGE Project, absorbing the overages;

7 WHEREAS, the program participants can no longer absorb those overages;

8 WHEREAS, the District Attorney proposes to set fees for participation in the program  
9 as follows:

<u>Annual Income</u>	<u>Fee</u>
\$0-8,999	\$100
\$9,000-15,999	\$350
\$16,000-29,999	\$650
\$30,000 and above	\$1,000

15 WHEREAS, Section 10.193-1 states that the newly authorized fee will be effective  
16 beginning the next fiscal year; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the maximum authorized fee for the First Offender Prostitution  
18 Program participants shall be \$1,000 beginning July 1, 2002.
